As many of you are aware last Monday, new Department of Education guidelines came out concerning practices and processes across NSW schools. As a number of schools across NSW have recently closed for deep cleaning the Department, acting on latest NSW Health advice, has put in new measures to ensure schools are safe and operational. We continual to seek parental support on ensuring all children, with even the mildest of flu like symptoms, are tested for COVID-19.

Importantly, parents now need to provide the school with a

copy of the negative COVID-19 test results before a child returns to school. This may be done through a screenshot sent to your child's teacher or through a hard copy sent to the Office. Thank you for your continued support in following this advice and best practice.

Latest Guidelines

It is critical that we continue to have updated and accurate contact details for all parents and carers. This includes mobile numbers, work numbers, addresses and emergency contacts. If your contact details have changed please contact the Office as soon as possible. We also ask that if anyone in the school community has a confirmed case of COVID-19 that you keep your child home and notify the school immediately.
