It was so lovely to see so many children (and staff) in orange or national dress last Tuesday. I had a very tough job judging the colouring competition with the winners being announced on Monday.



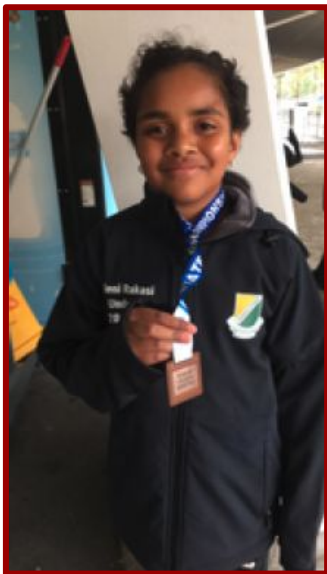

Check-In Assessment Information for Year 4 & Year 6 - Mrs Williams

Year 4 and 6 students will participate in a reading and numeracy Check-in assessment. The Check-in assessment is a NSW Department of Education online reading and numeracy assessment available to support schools to assess and monitor Year 4 and 6 student learning following the period of learning from home.

The check-in assessments can supplement existing school practices to identify how students are performing in literacy and numeracy and to help teachers tailor their teaching more specifically to student needs.

The assessment will be scheduled for our Year 4 and 6 students during Term 2 Week 1. If you have any questions please do not hesitate to contact your child's teacher.
