Drop Off & Pick Up Processes

As outlined yesterday, from Monday new processes are in place for dropping off and picking up children.

The children became well practiced at being independent last year and we ask that you continue to support these important life skills. Lunch orders can go in the canteen baskets in the morning, in the child's classroom and will be collected by our lovely canteen ladies.

All children, even Kinder, have been shown these systems. Lost property boxes are in the Office area.

Parents collecting children who are unwell or for any other reason will need to check in and out using the QR Code on the fence lines and in the Office area, as well as sign the disclaimer.

Attendance

May I remind parents and carers that all but essential appointments need to be made outside of school hours. While we understand that emergencies occur we do ask that all general appointments are made outside of school hours so children don't miss valuable learning time.






Lunar New Year - from Miss Vuong

Mobile Phones

Many of you may have read in the newspaper about the Department of Education's mobile phone policy. A copy of our policy and processes in regard to student's mobile phone usage may be found on the school website.

Most primary school children should not require a mobile phone at school however if your circumstances are such that your child requires a mobile phone at school please speak with myself or the Office about the processes we now need to follow. This will include an agreement signed by an adult or carer and the child.

Children must check the phone in and out from the Office.

Nut Aware

A number of children at our school have allergies to nuts and sesame seed products. The reaction that these children have is anaphylactic. This means that it is a potentially life threatening, severe allergic reaction and should always be treated as a medical emergency. Anaphylaxis occurs after exposure to an allergen (usually to foods, insects or chemicals), to which a person is allergic (ASCIA Australian Society of Clinical Immunology and Allergy). Teachers are trained in dealing with this life-threatening condition but we do seek your cooperation in ensuring the food you send with your child is *nut and sesame free*. Some things which we ask you not to send to school include Nutella, peanut butter, packets of nuts and dried fruit, Snickers or other chocolates, zaatar, muesli bars, sesame snaps and other products containing nuts and/or sesame.
