Close or Casual Contact

Attendance

Just a reminder that learning programs will continue until the last day of school, Thursday 16th December when the rolls are officially closed off for the year. After such a disruptive year it is important that children continue to attend regularly and consistently, if they are well enough to do so. All programs including Literacy Groups, maths lessons etc are continuing until the end of the year.

As is our normal practice, any child who is away will need an explanatory note or a medical certificate.

Pleased be advised that explanations such as "it was raining too hard," "my car broke down" or "I had an appointment," are marked as Explained but Unjustified which means it is an Unsatisfactory explanation.

In relation to families who are considering going overseas next year, may I remind you please that you need to apply for a leave exemption which may not be approved and I urge you to contact the school before booking any aeroplane tickets.

Also, please be aware that currently under the existing public health orders, families from overseas will need to quarantine at home before their children return to school
