### TECHNOLOGY

Just an FYI that some older children are accessing Discord from home, an online chat platform for children 13+. These groups have been named after classes and refer to the school, **but they are not sanctioned by the school or school staff**.

If you are a parent or carer who is deciding whether a child should be allowed to use an online service or platform, we strongly advise you to:

- Consider your child's readiness to the types of content and experiences they might encounter
- Help them understand what to do if they need help
- Provide ongoing support and monitor, through regular checks of your child's device/s
- Agree to some rules about each service or platform

#### ATTENDANCE

May I remind you please of the importance of your child being at school regularly. While we understand that children, of course, can get sick, the attendance rate goal is of 90% for all children across NSW (this is still one day a fortnight).

A number of reasons are classified as Unjustifiable for student absences. Please ring the Office if you require further support.

While parents can access SchoolBytes to excuse a child's absence, this can be modified at the Office if it is an unjustifiable reason. Parents can only access it for the week of the child's absence, as it then this part of SchoolBytes becomes inaccessible.

While the school gates open at 8:20am, children are not expected to be at school until 8:30am when playground supervision begins. There is no supervision before 8:30am.
