NSW PUBLIC SCHOOLS SURVEY: MRS KOULOOURIS

During week 10 of this term, our students in grades 3-6 will be taking part in the NSW Public Schools Survey. This new survey has replaced the Tell Them from Me survey that our grades 4-6 students previously participated in.

The NSW Public Schools Student Survey asks students about their experiences at school. Key topics in the survey include sense of belonging, teaching practices and student engagement. There are no wrong or right answers.

Participating students will be given a unique login to complete the survey online, ensuring it is completely anonymous. Students will complete the survey during class time. The survey will take approximately 15 minutes to complete. Participating in the survey is voluntary. Contact the school if you do not wish your child to participate. We value students completing this survey as their responses help us better understand their needs at school, allowing us to improve their learning by implementing programs that meet student educational and support needs. It also allows us to assess and evaluate the effectiveness of programs and their impact on student educational outcomes.
