At the workshop, areas covered will include:

- enrolling at your local government high school
- applying for an out of area placement at a government High school and what you should include for this
- applying for a non-government high school
- issues to consider when selecting a high School
- how to prepare your child for high school
- other questions you may have

I encourage all parents to attend this workshop if at all possible. It will allow you to have all the information you need to successfully enrol your child in High School in 2019. Please bring a blue or black pen with you to the workshop.
